#### SEEKING HOST FAMILIES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Nackawic High School has been participating in the New Brunswick International Student Program for the past two years. This year Nackawic Middle School is also hoping to host international students. As such, both schools are seeking host families to welcome international students into their homes for extended periods, ranging from 8 weeks in length to the full school year. Visiting students live with a host family, attend regular classes at Nackawic High School or Nackawic Middle School and participate in extra-curricular and community activities for the duration of their visit. A host family does not need to have a child who currently attends school. There is also a financial incentive for host families to help compensate for the extra expense of welcoming a guest for an extended period. We are currently seeking host families for Grade 11 students from China and Grade 8 students from Brazil during the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the year, starting in late January.
