

BY-LAW NO. A-7

**A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR
THE TOWN OF NACKAWIC**

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Nackawic as follows:

1. Title

This by-law may be cited as the "Town of Nackawic Planning Advisory Committee By law".

2. Authority

2.01 Pursuant to the provisions of the *Community Planning Act*, being Chapter C-12, RSNB, 1973, and amendments thereto, a Planning Advisory Committee is hereby established for the Town of Nackawic.

2.02 Subject to the provisions of this by-law, persons appointed to the Planning Advisory Committee may be members of the Council or servants of the municipality but the majority shall be other than such members and servants.

2.03 The Planning Advisory Committee may make rules for the conduct of its business and may, from time to time, amend the rules so long as the provisions therein do not conflict with the *Community Planning Act*, the *Municipalities Act*, the *Nackawic Town Charter* or the *By-laws* of the Town of Nackawic.

3. Appointments

3.01 The Planning Advisory Committee shall consist of seven members, six from the community at large and one from Town Council.

3.02 The Chair and Vice-Chair of the Planning Advisory Committee shall be appointed by the members of the Planning Advisory Committee.

3.03 Appointment of members to the committee shall be made by resolution of Council and except for the original appointments, shall be for a term of three years.

3.04 To be a member of the Planning Advisory Committee a person must be:

- (i) eligible to vote under the *Municipalities Act*, and

(ii) a resident of the municipality.

3.05 The Council may, by resolution, remove any member from the Planning Advisory Committee.

4. Repeal Provision

4.01 By-law No. 62, A By-Law To Establish A Planning Advisory Committee, passed by Town Council on May 21, 1985, and amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.

4.02 The repeal of By-law No. 62, A By-Law To Establish A Planning Advisory Committee, and amendments thereto, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.

5. Effective Date of By-Law

This By-Law does not become effective until it has been filed in the Registry Office.
