The cost for dogs that have been vaccinated, spayed or neutered is \$15.00. “No person who is a resident in the Town of Nackawic shall own a dog without having a valid license for that dog under the Town’s Dog By-Law”. Fines for not having a dog tag start at \$25.00.
